# Is it time to increase your internet speed?

If you notice your internet beginning to slow down, it might be time to evaluate what speed you need. Here are a few factors to help determine your ideal connection speed:

- Number of Users and Devices: How many different devices are people in your home typically using at the same time? (Computers, smartphones, tablets, gaming consoles, smart TVs, smart home devices, etc.)

- Gaming: How often do members of your household play online games on PC, Playstation, Xbox, Nintendo Switch, or via smartphones?
- Streaming Audio: How often does your household stream audio on apps such as Spotify, Pandora, Amazon Alexa, and Google Home?
- Uploading Video: Do you have a video doorbell or security cameras on the property?
   These can require elevated upload speeds. (Fortunately, PTCI's fiber plans offer symmetrical speeds which guarantees a great upload experience.)

### Understanding **CPNI** rules

Customer proprietary network information (CPNI) is the data collected by PTCI and other telecommunications companies about a consumer's telephone calls. It includes the time, date, duration and destination number of each call, the type of network a consumer subscribes to, and any other information that appears on the consumer's telephone bill.

Telemarketers or customer service agents working on behalf of telephone companies must go through an additional customer authentication layer and ask for the customer's consent prior to accessing the billing information or before using or sharing that information for any purpose, including but not limited to, offering an upsell or any change of services. Usually, this is done at the beginning of a call from the telemarketer to the telephone subscriber.

The U.S. Telecommunications Act of 1996 granted the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) authority to regulate how CPNI can be used and to enforce related consumer information privacy provisions. The rules in the 2007 FCC CPNI Order further restrict CPNI use and created new notification and reporting requirements.
