The more devices you have, the more speed you need

How many internet-connected devices do you have in your home? It might be more than you think!

Start by counting your personal devices — such as your laptop, tablet, and cell phone — and do the same for all family members living there. Next, count the number of smart TVs and streaming devices, followed by the number of smart home devices including smart speakers, smart door bells, smart security video cameras, smart appliances, and smart thermostats. What was your total? Deloitte's 2023 Connected Consumer Study found that the average U.S. household has 25 internet-connected devices.

This amount of simultaneous internet use can "eat up" your bandwidth and lead to slowdowns and buffering. The solution is to upgrade to an internet plan with greater bandwidth and faster speeds.

PTCI offers a variety of residential plans with speeds of up to 1 Gbps (depending on your area of residence).
